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**Re: Old Sanitary Landfill Grass Cutting Services – Rejection of Bids**

Tammy Newcomb, Assistant to the County Administrator, stated that bids were solicited to perform grass cutting services at the old sanitary landfill. The following bids were received:

- Melvin Taylor                      \$1,480 per year (\$740 per cut)
- The Lawn Wizard                \$2,200 per year (\$1,100 per cut)
- W.R. Temple                        \$3,000 per year (\$1,500 per cut)

The previous contract between Brunswick County and Melvin Taylor is \$630.00 per year. Due to the significant increase in the bids and current fiscal constraints, it is recommended to reject all bids and to re-bid the project.

Upon motion of Ms. Drummond, seconded by Mr. Cataldo, and unanimously carried, the Board rejected all bids and authorized a re-bid of the project.
