**Re: Declaration of Local Emergency – Hurricane Sandy**

Ms. Woolridge, County Administrator, stated that Governor McDonnell declared a state of emergency on Friday, October 26, 2012, in anticipation of Hurricane Sandy. Due to the potential impact of Hurricane Sandy to Brunswick County, Ms. Woolridge declared a local emergency on Sunday, October 28, 2012. In accordance with Virginia State Code, the Board of Supervisors must convene a meeting within fourteen (14) days to re-affirm the action.

Upon motion of Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Cataldo, and unanimously carried, the Board declared a local emergency due to Hurricane Sandy.

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Emergency Management of the County of Brunswick

hereby finds:

1. That due to Hurricane Sandy, the County of Brunswick is facing dangerous conditions; and
2. That due to Hurricane Sandy, a condition of extreme peril to life and property necessitates the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED** that an emergency exists throughout the County of Brunswick; and

**IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED** that during the existence of said emergency, the powers, functions, and duties of the Emergency Management of the County of Brunswick shall be those prescribed by State Law and the Ordinances, Resolutions, and approved plans of the County of Brunswick in order to mitigate the effects of said emergency.
